Mentor Program FAQs

Q: Who can be a mentor?

A: Martin- Gatton CAFE Employees with two+ years of service, who have completed Unconscious Bias training, SuperVision, or equivalent program.

Q: What is the length of the program?

A: Six months

Q: How many meetings are we required to have? A: Minimum of two (Zoom, Microsoft Teams, face to face). More if desired.

Q: Do I need to keep a log of our meetings/conversations? A: No

Q: What training /support will I have as a mentor?

A: Mentor will complete the Martin-Gatton CAFE Mentor Orientation training course, receive a resource packet, receive monthly newsletters, and help tip emails throughout the six month program.

Q: Does my supervisor need to approve?

A: Yes

Q: Will my mentee be in my department? A: The program is college wide. While it is possible that your mentee will be in your department, it is unlikely.

Q: Can the mentee or mentor choose to end the program early?
