

## **Process**


• Double click the email you would like to convert. It will open to a full screen version.



• Click the File tab.




• Click Save as Adobe PDF




 A Save As window will open where you will need to select what file the PDF will be saved under. You can make the file selection in the options on the right side of the box. Note make sure to rename your file so you can find it easily.






Note make sure to rename your file so you can find it easily.
